2018 Chardon Square Association Service Scholarship Guidelines

Any individual who is a resident of the Chardon Local School District (as defined by the Chardon Local Schools) who has applied to an accredited vocational, two or four year degree-granting institute of post-secondary education is eligible to apply for the Chardon Square Association Service Scholarship.

Qualifications and Guidelines

1. The applicant must be a resident of the Chardon Local School District.
2. The applicant must submit a completed scholarship application form and essay.
3. The applicant has attained a minimum grade point average of 3.00.
4. The applicant has a written referral from a Chardon Square Association member in good standing.
5. The applicant has completed at least five (5) hours of service to a Chardon Square Association sponsored event during their senior year of high school.

Application Procedure

1. Each applicant must complete the application and return it to the Chardon Square Association by April 15, 2018.
2. Written recommendations from one Chardon Square Association member in good standing must accompany the application.
3. The successful applicant(s) will be awarded the scholarship during their school sponsored scholarship award ceremony.
4. Please read and complete all sections thoroughly. If there is insufficient space for your answers, include additional sheets of paper with your application. This application and any attachments must be typed or printed legibly.

Amount of Scholarship

The amount and number of scholarships awarded in any given year will be determined by the Chardon Square Association Scholarship Committee.

Applications will be made available at the Guidance Office of Chardon High School, Notre Dame Cathedral Latin, and online at chardonsquareassociation.org. Completed applications should be mailed to the Chardon Square Association Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 1063, Chardon, Ohio 44024.
